### ➤ MAKE BOOKMARKS

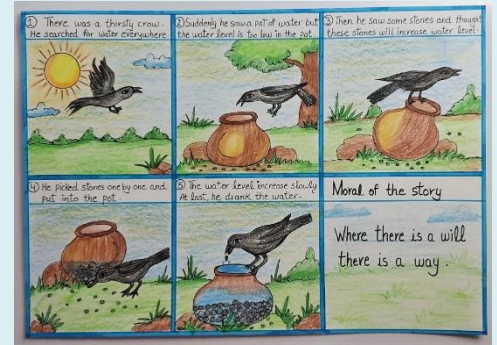
