Art and Craft Make a landscape or painting with paper collage on **A3 size sheet**.

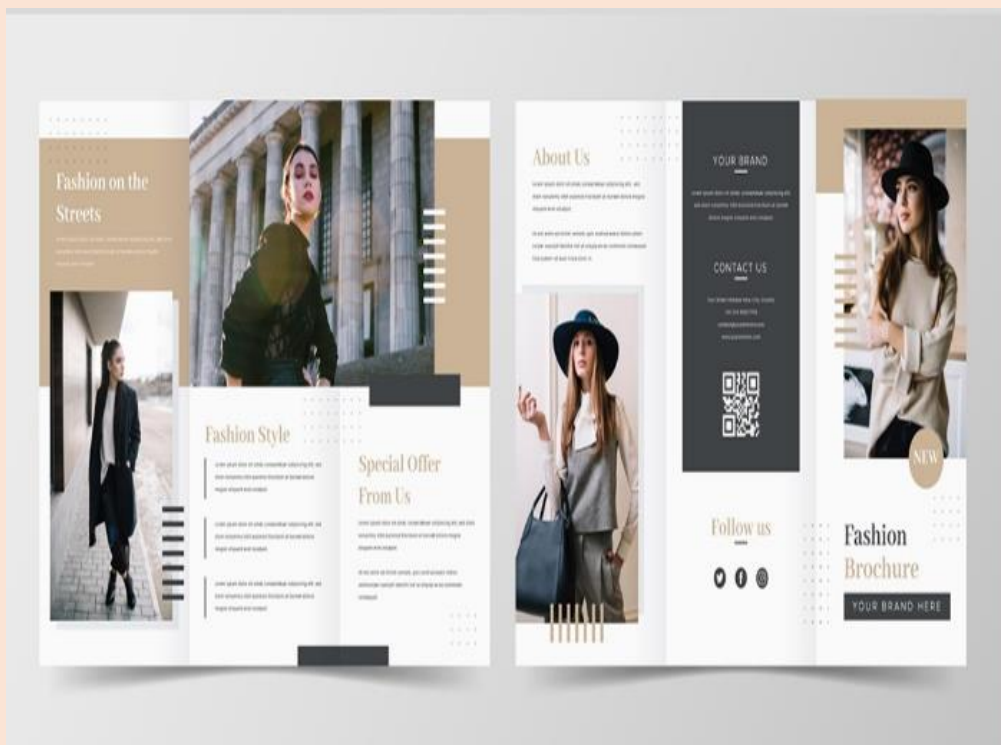
